2007 Highlighted Accomplishments:

NARAL Pro-Choice Texas

- Helped prevent the passage of all new bills that would have been detrimental to women's reproductive health and choices during the 80th legislative session
 - Co-drafted an omnibus *Prevention First* bill as well as several bills and amendments regarding crisis pregnancy centers
 - Compiled comprehensive legislative updates, tracking over 30 bills related to women's reproductive health, that were distributed weekly to legislative offices and women's health coalition partners during the legislative session
 - Raised over \$45,000 at 21st annual Celebration of Choice benefit fundraiser
- ### NARAL Pro-Choice Texas Foundation
- Received a grant from the New York-based Institute for Reproductive Health to research the availability and price of over-the-counter emergency contraception at every pharmacy in Houston
 - Launched the online resource www.FindEC.org to disseminate the findings of this research
 - Partnered with over 20 progressive organizations to form the Houston Area Table, a branch of the Texas Table coalition
 - Continued commitment to train future leaders by partnering with campus organizers at the University of Texas at Austin, Rice University, Southern Methodist University, and the University of North Texas

11 professional development trainings attended by NPCT staff

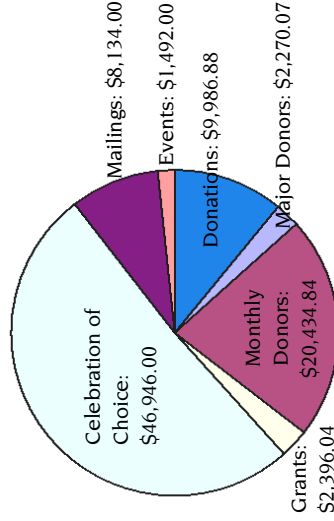

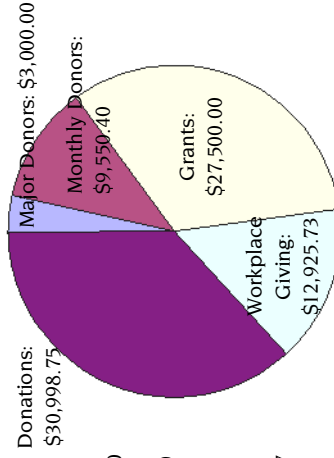

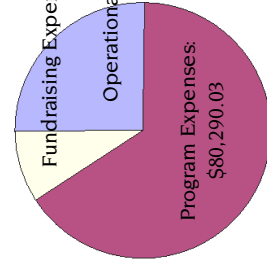
NARAL Pro-Choice Texas Income



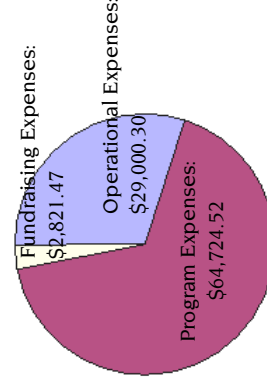
NARAL Pro-Choice Texas Foundation Income
